Hayes County Commissioners
April 7, 2020

An Emergency Meeting of the Hayes County Board of Commissioners was held April 7, 2020 at 7:17 P.M. at Farkleberry's in Hayes Center, Nebraska. The Open Meetings Act was available for review. Roll call: Wayne Christner – present by phone; Barry Richards, present; Jeffrey Unger, present by phone; and Susan Messersmith.

Unger moved, second by Richards to adopt a disaster declaration stating: Hayes County has suffered a large prairie fire aided by strong winds causing severe damage to public and private property, disruption of utility service, and endangerment of health and safety of the citizens of Hayes County within the disaster area.

Therefore, the Chair of the Hayes County Board of Commissioners has declared a state of emergency authorized under Nebraska State Statute R.R.S. 81-829.50 on behalf of Hayes County and will execute for and on behalf of Hayes County, the expenditure of emergency funds from all available sources, the invoking of mutual aid agreements, and the applying to the State of Nebraska for assistance from the Governor's Emergency Fund and any other resources he/she deems necessary in the fulfillment of his/her duties. Roll call vote: Richards, yes; Christner, yes; Unger, yes. Motion carried.

Chairman Unger adjourned the meeting at 7:20 P.M.
